560-10-30-.13 Non-Resident Members of the Armed Services Qualifications for Ad Valorem Tax Exemptions for Motor Vehicles.

(1) Any active member of the armed services who meets all qualifications as set forth herein may apply for an exemption from motor vehicle ad valorem taxes for:

- (a) Any motor vehicles registered solely in the service member's name.
- (b) One (1) vehicle registered in both their name and the name of their spouse.

(2) For each vehicle which the service member seeks exemption, the service member shall provide the Department:

(a) An affidavit as set forth in this Regulation, certified by the service member's commanding officer, and a notarized signature of the service member stating that the service member is:

- 1. An active armed services personnel member,
- 2. A non-resident of Georgia,
- 3. Stationed at a military instrumentality within the State of Georgia solely by the virtue of military orders.
