SUBJECT: Hunting Season for Turkey

1. AFI 32-7064 *Integrated Natural Resources Management* directs resource managers to develop and promote hunting opportunities on installations, where feasible. The hunting program at Robins includes seasons for small game, waterfowl, and large mammals such as white-tailed deer and hog. Several hunters have recently expressed an interest in hunting turkey on base. Wild turkeys require a diversity of habitat types in close proximity to one another. The availability of these habitat types on Robins is limited. As a result, turkeys are not abundant. However, the existing population is sufficient to support hunting to a degree, provided that certain restrictions are employed.
2. Turkey hunting on Robins may take place each Friday through Sunday, during the season established by the Georgia Department of Natural Resources (DNR), and only in Hunting Area D. The number of turkey hunters will be restricted to 10 per day, and hunters will be issued permits on a first come, first served basis. Bag limits are those established by DNR.
3. Anyone hunting for turkey on Robins must carry the appropriate State hunting license and a base turkey-hunting permit.
4. Weapons authorized for hunting turkey are shotguns with No. 2 or smaller shot, muzzle-loading black powder rifles, and bows and arrows. No other weapons are authorized.
5. Hunting rules established in RAFB Instruction 32-7064 and by DNR must be obeyed. Any violation of these rules could lead to the suspension of hunting privileges on Robins AFB.
