# **COLONEL JENNIFER A. B. CARNS**

Colonel Jennifer Ann Branigan Carns is the Commander of the 5th Combat Communications Group at Robins Air Force Base, Georgia. The 5th MOB is the last remaining active duty combat communications group. The group of over 700 Airmen, Civilians, and one United Kingdom officer from over twenty career fields is comprised of a combat communications support squadron, two combat communications mission squadrons and an engineering installation squadron. She directs the training, mobilization, and deployment of multicapable personnel, computers, radios, transport systems, specialized engineering services and supporting equipment to enable wartime and peacetime operations for combatant commanders, joint task forces, and Air Force components and Department of Defense Agencies. These missions also include direct support taskings for the United States Northern Command and the United States Secret Service.

Colonel Carns entered into the Air Force through the University of Florida's Air Force ROTC program. She has served in a variety of assignments and



deployed multiple times in support of Operations ENDURING FREEDOM and IRAQI FREEDOM. Her command experience includes the 85th Engineering Installation Squadron, 65th Communications Squadron and the 609th Air Communications Squadron's Detachment 4. Prior to her current assignment, she was the Future Operations Division Chief at Joint Force Headquarters – Department of Defense Information Network.
