


# Robins has \$3.38 billion economic impact on Peach State

**R**obins Air Force Base contributes \$3.38 billion to the Georgia economy, according to the installation's latest economic impact statement. That represents a \$237 million growth over the previous year.

Published annually, the statement provides general information about the economic impact the installation has on the state of Georgia.


The report is also distributed to federal, state and local officials.

The fiscal 2019 statement sizes Robins' workforce at 23,967 – a figure that is made up of 14,821 appropriated fund civilians, 6,188 military members and 2,958 other employees.

The statement also says Robins doled out \$1.54 billion in salaries. The largest chunk of that money – \$1.12 billion – went to civilians working on base, while military members accounted for \$400.8 million. Non-federal civilians and contract employees accounted for just more than \$14.8 million.

Additionally, the base awarded \$7.1 billion in contracts during fiscal 2019. Of that amount, the base awarded \$518 million to Georgia firms, with the lion's share – \$224 million – to firms in Houston County.

The top five contractors in terms of contracts awarded were Boeing, Northrup Grumman, Lockheed Martin, Raytheon and General Atomics.

## ABOUT THE STATEMENT

The Economic Impact Statement provides information about the economic impact Robins Air Force Base has on the state of Georgia. It's made available to federal, state and local officials, business leaders and the general public. An installation's economic impact on the state is calculated by identifiable on- and off-base spending in the state from gross expenditures. All financial figures are rounded to the nearest dollar. This statement is for fiscal 2019. The report is based on data analyzed by the Air Force Sustainment Center Financial Management Operating Location at Robins.

## AT A GLANCE

There are 23,967 total personnel at Robins Air Force Base, including 6,188 military members, 14,821 appropriated fund civilians and 2,958 employees who are funded by other sources. Robins has an annual federal payroll of \$1.54 billion and annual expenditures of \$580 million. It also creates more than \$1.27 billion in jobs. Based on that data, Robins has a \$3.38 billion total annual economic impact on Georgia — a \$237 million increase from fiscal 2018.


