

Relocation Assistance

Relocation information and assistance to military personnel and their families who are involved in or anticipating a permanent change of station (PCS) move. Services include:

- ⇒ Newcomers In-Processing
- ⇒ Smooth Move

Transition Assistance

Provides separating/retiring members and their families the tools and knowledge required to make a successful transition to the civilian sector. Services include:

- ⇒ Initial Transition Counseling
- ⇒ Pre-Separation Counseling
- ⇒ 3 Day Transition GPS Workshop
- ⇒ Capstone Appointments
- ⇒ VA Benefits Advisors

Voting Services

Provides information on registering to vote, absentee voting, important voting dates/timelines and training for Unit Voting Assistance Officers.

Exceptional Family Member Program—Family Support (EFMP-FS)

EFMP-FS is a community support function. It is designed to provide coordination of family support services on & off base through family needs assessments to determine the needs and resources required for each family. Services include:

- ⇒ Information & Referral (non-medical)
- ⇒ Family Needs Assessment
- ⇒ Info on local, state, federal resources

Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP)

The SBP is a government program which makes it possible for retiring members to ensure that after their death, their eligible survivors receive a portion of their retired pay in the form of a monthly annuity.

- One-on-one pre-retirement briefing to member and spouse
- ⇒ Cancel/change SBP (Retirees)

The M&FRC serves as a primary prevention agency and functions to ensure resources required to support active duty and their families are available.

The M&FRC designs, develops, and conducts family programs according to base and community needs. Services are available for all active duty and their families, including single Airmen, DoD civilians, and retirees.

What type of Resources are Available?

The Robins M&FRC offers a variety of services including information & referral, financial assistance, relocation assistance, transition assistance, employment programs, spouses orientations, and more! Other classes can be created in keeping with the needs and requests of the Robins community.



M&FRC Programs

Air Force Aid Society

Provides emergency financial assistance to Air Force members, both active duty and retired and their families through interest-free loans or grants. Emergency assistance can include:

- ⇒ Basic Living Expenses
- ⇒ Utility bills
- \Rightarrow Food
- ⇒ Emergency travel due to death/ critical illness in the family
- ⇒ Car repairs
- ⇒ Medical/dental expenses

Employment Assistance

Enhances the marketability and employability of spouses and active duty members through individual career counseling and classes to include:

- ⇒ Job Search Skills
- ⇒ Resume & Interview assistance
- ⇒ Career Planning and Counseling assistance

Personal Financial Management

Offers information, education, and counseling on a variety of financial topics to include:

- ⇒ Budgeting
- ⇒ Debt Management
- ⇒ Home Buying
- ⇒ TSP Saving for the future
- ⇒ Moving Out of the Dorms

Air Force Families Forever

A long-term survivor program established to provide support to family members of deceased Regular Air Force, U.S. Space Force, and Air Reserve Component.

Gold Star Families

Survivors of service members who died while engaged in combat or military conflict with an opposing foreign force or as a result of an international terrorist attack against the U.S. Families of service members who are unaccounted for from our nations past conflicts (i.e. Korean War, Cold War, Vietnam War).

Family Readiness

Provides mobility, deployment and remote tour assistance to help single and married DoD personnel and families meet pre-deployment, sustainment, reintegration, and post deployment challenges. The program includes:
